NOTICE OF RACE/SAILING INSTRUCTION SUPPLEMENT

1. RULES

NoR 1.9 is deleted.

1.10 If the format is slalom:

- (a) When at the starting signal the race committee identifies a board on the course side of the starting line, the race committee shall signal a general recall.
- (b) If the race committee acts under rule NoR/SI 1.10(a) above and the board is identified, she shall be disqualified without a hearing, even if the race is abandoned. The race committee shall hail or display her sail number, and she shall leave the course area immediately. If the race is restarted or resailed, she shall not sail in it.
- (c) If the race was completed but was later abandoned by the protest committee, and if the race is resailed, a board disqualified under rule NoR/SI 1.10 (b) above may sail in it.

This changes RRS 29.2.

1.11 NoR 18.7 and 18.8 are deleted and replaced with:

The race committee may signal that boards shall sail on a specific tack during the 10 seconds before and 10 seconds after the starting signal is made, by displaying a green flag for starboard tack or a red flag for port tack, before or with the warning signal. When a board breaks this rule without affecting another board, she is exonerated for her breach.

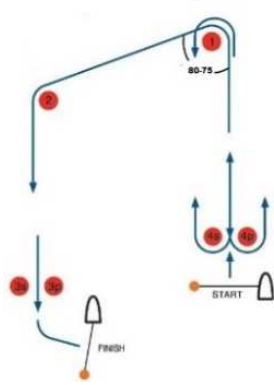

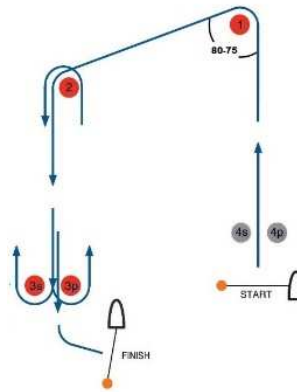

Course racing – Trapezoid course

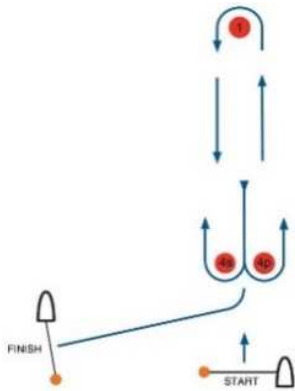

I2	Start-1-4P/4S-1-2-3P-Finish

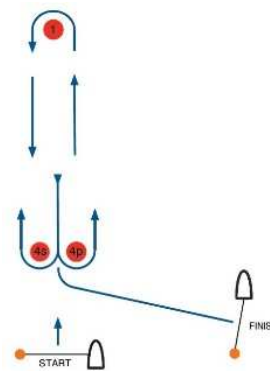


signal	mark rounding order

Course racing - W/L course

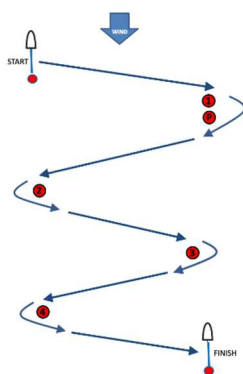

LG2	Start-1-4P/4S-1-4S-Finish

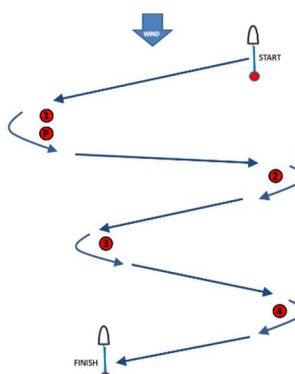

LR2	Start-1-4P/4S-1-4P-Finish

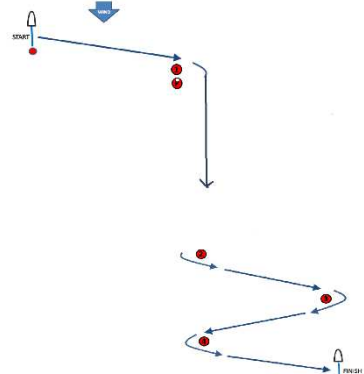
Slalom sprint



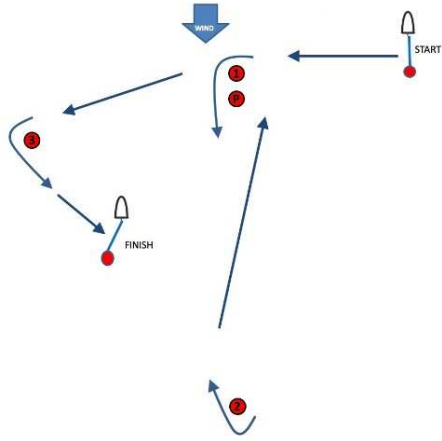
