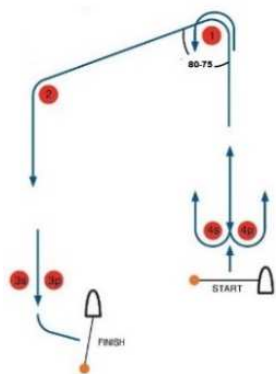

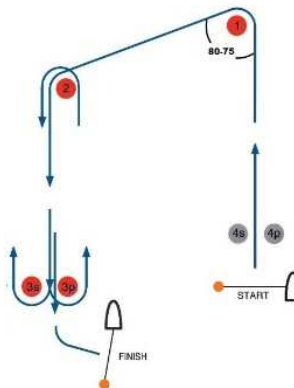

### Course racing – Trapezoid course

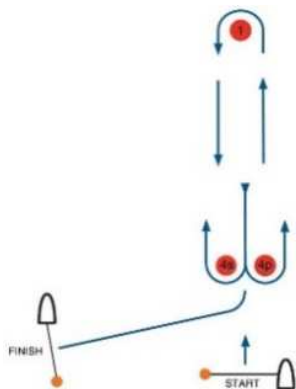

I2	Start-1-4P/4S-1-2-3P-Finish

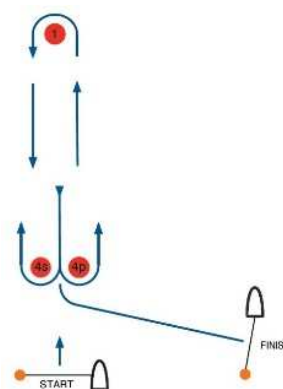


signal	mark rounding order

### Course racing - W/L course

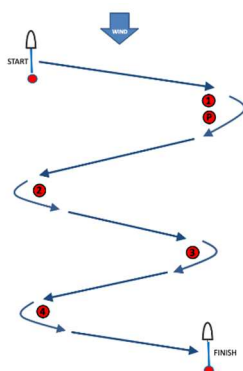

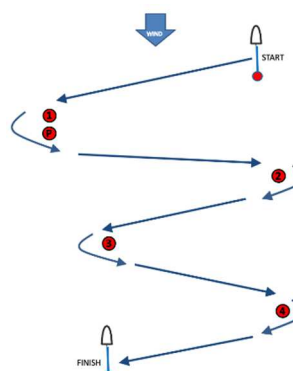

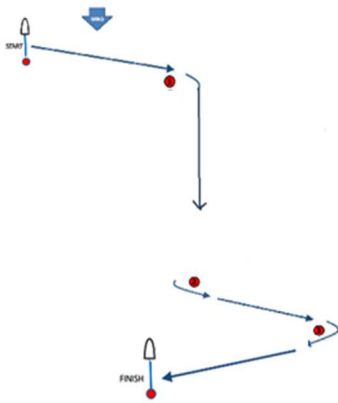

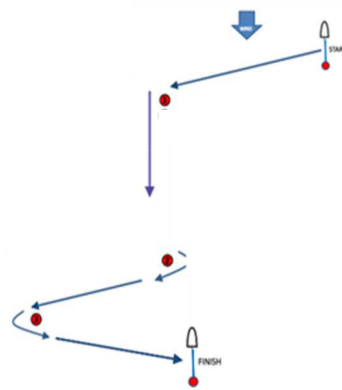

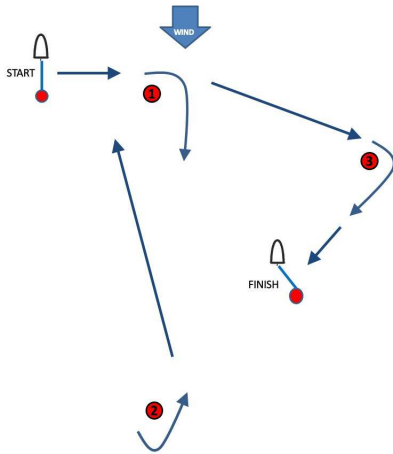

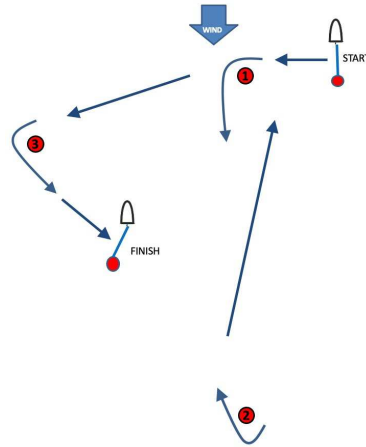
